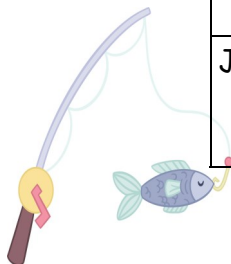

5. Sign your names and the date at the bottom.



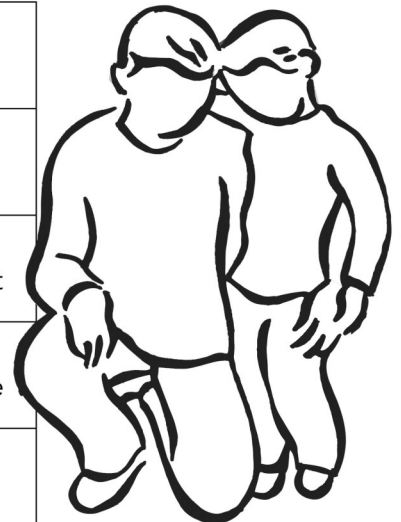
FATHERS OF FAITH

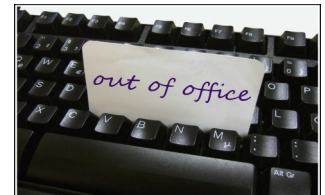

MICROSCHOOL LAUNCH SUB TASK FORCE UPDATE

The Administrative Board and the Vision Task Force have identified three initiatives that we believe God is calling us to pursue. These include 1) remodeling and expanding the Kitchen, 2) enhancing security measures during public events and 3) implementing a Christian Micro-school for parents who are looking for options beyond the public school system.

We have been reporting much on initiative #3 above through the work that is being carried out through the Microschool Launch Sub Task Force. Last month, we reported about the Parent Information Night we held on April 24. We failed to report that eight prospective families attended that meeting! These families represented 26 children, 18 of school age. It was a joy to have one family from ECOG and another from a sister Churches of God congregation. We had our second Parent Information Night on May 4. There, we welcomed three families representing 10 children; 6 of which were school age. We were blessed at both meetings by several individuals from ECOG that came to provide childcare. Thanks so much to all of you!

PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT

(from an anonymous person)



"Scammers," "hackers," "awful people," whatever you want to call them, we must all be aware of them. You've all read the articles that give you the "red flag" warnings to look for, but if you are in the situation, it is easy to forget them all. I would like to highlight a few suggestions, as our family just experienced this with a sizable financial loss.

- Scammers will often play on your fears. If they tell you not to tell anyone, make sure you have at least one person in your life that you know you will go to NO MATTER WHAT the scammer says. This is non-negotiable. The scammer wants to isolate you and create fear.
- To ensure a hacker cannot gain access to your computer camera, keep the camera turned off or cover it. Further protection against your camera being hacked is to keep your software up to date, along with having security software installed on your computer.
- Microsoft does not contact users individually. If they do, this is a huge red flag. They are not monitoring your computer to tell you something is wrong. If they are monitoring it, it is to hack you. "Microsoft" can be a hacker. Don't call the number on the screen. Don't run the scan they offer to complete for you. Do not give them any more information than they may have already taken from your computer.
- Hackers can copy bank letterhead and then email you a "letter," but it is not your bank. CALL your bank for the fraud department. Do not let the nice hacker "connect" you to your bank. (In fact, in all these situations, CALL a person instead of using the computer.)

And, if you DO get scammed or hacked, don't be embarrassed. Tell someone and then contact the police. These people are professionals. They are good at tricking people. Don't fall for it! Protect yourself and your investments. Take your time on your computer before you click a link. If it doesn't seem right, assume it isn't!

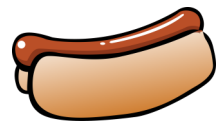

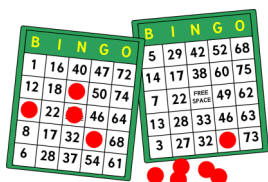

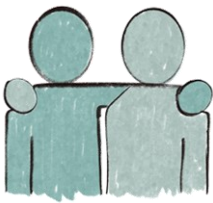

New Ways to Give to ECOG

You will also have the option of "text to give," which provides you a 10-digit number to text and a category in which to make your gift. Both new options will require you to set up an account the first time you use them. The bulletin will provide the QR code and the text number, along with the categories with which to choose from. These are two separate options for you to use, along with the traditional placement of a gift in an offering plate or giving online from your computer or phone. We also returned to passing offering plates during the 10:30 AM service, while still having time for praises to be shared. During the 8:00 AM service, offering plates will remain on a table in the back of the Sanctuary. We hope you will find it convenient to use one of the four ways to give. 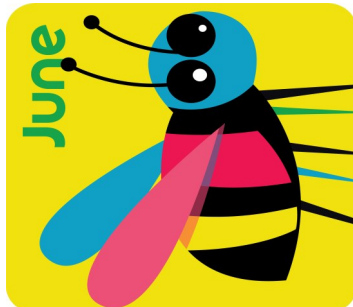
