From Gratitude to Faithful Praise

Gratitude is the beginning of faith; faith leads us to the ultimate gratitude.

Gratitude is often the first quiet step of faith. Before answers come, before circumstances change, gratitude teaches the heart to notice God's presence and provision. Scripture reminds us, "In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you" (1 Thessalonians 5:18, KJV). Giving thanks, even in uncertain moments, opens our eyes to God's faithfulness already at work.

As gratitude grows, it naturally leads us into deeper trust. When we remember what God has done, faith finds solid ground. "Faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen" (Hebrews 11:1, KJV). Gratitude strengthens that hope by anchoring it in God's past mercies. Each thankful prayer becomes a reminder that the same God who carried us before will carry us again.

Faith, in turn, leads us to ultimate gratitude, not just for blessings received, but for God himself. "Thanks be unto God for his unspeakable gift" (2 Corinthians 9:15, KJV). This gratitude reaches beyond circumstances and rests in Christ, the greatest gift of all. When gratitude begins our journey and faith guides our steps, our hearts learn lasting praise, thankful not only for what God gives, but for who he is.

A Safe Haven in the Storm

Prolific hymn writer Charles Wesley penned the beloved hymn “Jesus, Lover of My Soul” in 1739. According to tradition, Wesley wrote the words after surviving a violent storm at sea. During the chaos, a frightened bird is said to have flown through a window and sought shelter in the folds of Wesley’s coat, a small but powerful image of refuge in the midst of danger.

The opening stanza of the hymn echoes that sense of protection and trust:

*Jesus, lover of my soul,
let me to thy bosom fly,
while the nearer waters roll,
while the tempest still is high.
Hide me, O my Savior, hide,
till the storm of life is past;
safe into the haven guide;
O receive my soul at last.*



These words call to mind the frightened disciples in Matthew 8:23–27. Tossed by wind and waves, they feared for their lives and cried out to Jesus for rescue. With a word, he calmed the storm and reminded them of his power and presence.

We, too, face seasons when life feels overwhelming. In those moments, we can take refuge in our Savior, trusting that he is our safe haven and that, no matter the storm, our destination is secure.

Remember to put your name on your dish to ensure it's return.

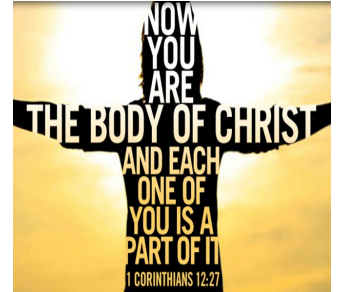


In Touch Devotional Booklets Will Now Be Distributed at ECOG

MICROSCHOOL TASK FORCE UPDATE

The Pharos Academy/Microschool Task Force met recently to review progress and plan for our Fall opening. Here's a summary of key updates from the meeting:

Old Business

- 1-100 Envelope Fundraiser: Having received an update on the funding received through this initiative, the Task Force decided to keep the wall display up, with expectations that momentum will build once the school year begins.
- Facilities Update: The ECOG Board is in the process of hiring a contractor to complete required work.

New Business: Fundraising

- We are following up with McAlister's for results from their recent fundraiser.
- We are coordinating a Senator's Game Fundraiser in July (Faith Night). A special ticket link will be provided, with Pharos receiving \$4 per ticket purchased. *(See article on pg. 8.)*
- We will have a Dine and Donate event on Wednesday, June 10 at the Texas Roadhouse in Camp Hill, PA. This event has been advertised on Pharos Academy's website and Facebook page

Administrative & Operational Updates

- PA Sales Tax Exemption: Paperwork has been submitted. The application is on hold until Pharos completes three months of operations, after which we will report back to the PA Department of Revenue.
- Articles of Incorporation: These were amended to include the required Dissolution clause.
- Federal Tax Exemption (Form 1023): We are working with the accounting firm, Cohick & Associates. They will assist with preparation and filing. Two members of the Task Force met with an accountant from Cohick & Associates on May 8.
- Insurance: We have secured a policy through Mark Swartz at Bower Insurance for \$1,905 annually. The provider recommends adopting a Sexual Abuse Policy; we have requested a template from Bower Insurance to help us draft a policy.
- Key Documents: Drafts of the Handbook, Code of Conduct, and Non-Employee Teacher Contract have been distributed. These will be reviewed and edited at the next meeting.
- Technology & Agreements: Pastor Jensen is preparing questions for the ECOG Board regarding use of their computer equipment and network to find out what Pharos is permitted to use.
- Tuition Payments: The task force approved the use of Vanco for electronic collections.
- Banking: We will obtain advice from the Administrative Assistant at ECOG regarding Vanco and accounting software. We will also speak with her to get information that will help us obtain a credit card at Members 1st FCU while we await non-profit approvals.

MICROSCHOOL TASK FORCE UPDATE (Continued from pg. 13)**School & Class Updates**

- Flyers and the website are being updated to reflect our new direction focused on stand-alone classes.
- The task force approved up to \$500 in discretionary spending by the Head of School for advertising at vendor events, homeschool groups, social media, and printed materials.
- Potential Classes (subject to final confirmation):
- We have a teacher who is willing to teach the following classes: Letter of the Week (PreK-K), God Made Everything (Early Elem), Intro to Church and Bible History (Early Elem), and God's Amazing World (Early Elem). Each of these classes will take place weekly for 90 minutes.
- We have another teacher willing to teach Latin Immersion (High School) and Middle School Latin. Each of these classes will take place twice a week for 60 minutes.
- We have a third teacher willing to teach Algebra 1 for Middle/High School Students. These classes will take place twice a week for 60 minutes.
- The Head of School will continue reaching out to additional potential teachers and classes.

The next meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, May 26, 2026, at 6:30 PM. The task force welcomes continued prayer and support from the church community. 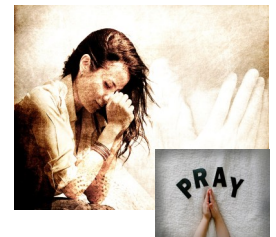


Meals Ministry Available
